Number of Students Participants: **70** (25 – AMIETE/ DIPETE and 45 – ISF students)

After the inauguration program on, brief overview of the workshop and M-SIPS was given by **Prof. Ajay Thakare, Chairman, Amravati Centre**. He addressed the gathering that now – a days the use of any Electronic system is user friendly. Due to this, if any sort of problem occurs in the system, it is very difficult to troubleshoot. The user has to be totally dependent on the supplier. Many a times extra cost is added by the supplier to meet the company's repair and service charges. He told that therefore it is a need to understand the in-built electronic circuitry so that these types of problems don't arise. He talked on the need to promote large-scale manufacturing, to offset disability and to attract domestic and global investments into the Electronic System Design and Manufacturing (ESDM) sectors. He gave the details of the Modified Special Incentive Package Scheme (M-SIPS) as notified vide Notification no. 175 dated 27th July 2012 in Part-I , Section 1 of the Gazette of India. He added that the scheme is available for both new projects and expansion projects. The details of these can be obtained on the respective websites. He expressed his gratitude towards the IETE Head Quarters for permitting conduction of such a workshop at the Centre.

Executive member, Prof. Nilesh Kasat, presented the objectives of the IETE. He briefly explained the functioning of the Amravati Centre. He further gave the detail report of the number of activities conducted in the past by the centre. He however added that such type of HRD ministry sponsored activity of Electronic System Design as One day workshop is being conducted for the first time.

Gues, Dr. S. A. Ladhake, Principal, Sipna COE, Amravati and facilitator of the then Amravati Sub-Centre and founder Chairman of the Amravati Centre, congratulated the Centre's EC members and Office bearers that they have taken a strong initiative for the technological development of this region through such type of workshop. He also put his view on the current scenario for the Electronic Industries in India. He expressed his satisfaction over the large enthusiastic turn out of the students of AMIETE , DIPETE and ISF of the Amravati Centre in attending this workshop. He wished all the best for the one day workshop.

Invited Speaker, Engineer Mr. Gajendra Bedare, Owner of the Electronic Manufacturing Company at Saturna, MIDC, Amravati, spoke on the occasion. At the outset he thanked the Amravati Centre Office bearers for inviting him for the workshop. He started his interactive presentation by rapid fire questions to the attending students. This made the students to deeply involved in the session. He taught the various types of soldering techniques, its advantages and applications. Not only did he gave the scope of Electronic Industry in India, but also focused on further research and development across the globe. He also gave brief presentation on the Tina software, which is used for PCB layout and its preparation. He introduced his support team members, who would assist the students during their visit to his manufacturing company in MIDC area. Looking at the strength (total 70) of the student participants, he suggested to form batches for a proper interactive guidance during the visit in the afternoon session.

Second invited Speaker, Mr. Atul Mahashabde, an Entrepreneur in Amravati, spoke on Entrepreneurship. He told at length the Electronic Market Scenario and its changing dimensions within and outside India. He felt happy to inform the students about his recent visit to the Gujarat state Industries, where he could differentiate the taxes levied on the various Electronic items. He encouraged the students for self employment and guided them o how to become a successful entrepreneur. Students were enthusiastic enough to enquire about processes involved and government's role and documents in becoming entrepreneur for a small scale Electronic manufacturing unit. He promised the students to contact him for any further sessions required by him on any such issues.

Third invited speaker, Prof. Swapnil Potdar, Training and placement Officer at Sipna COET, Amravati, guided on Job Opportunities and Career path. He explained the market scenario and the core placement issues. He emphasized on the core Electronic Company jobs, as the present companies are maximum based on software and automation.
